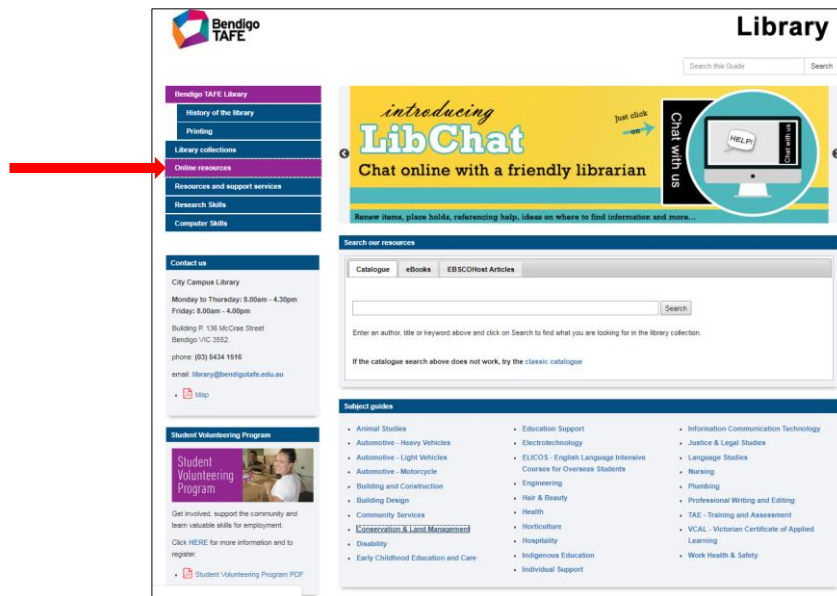


# How to use Australian Standards

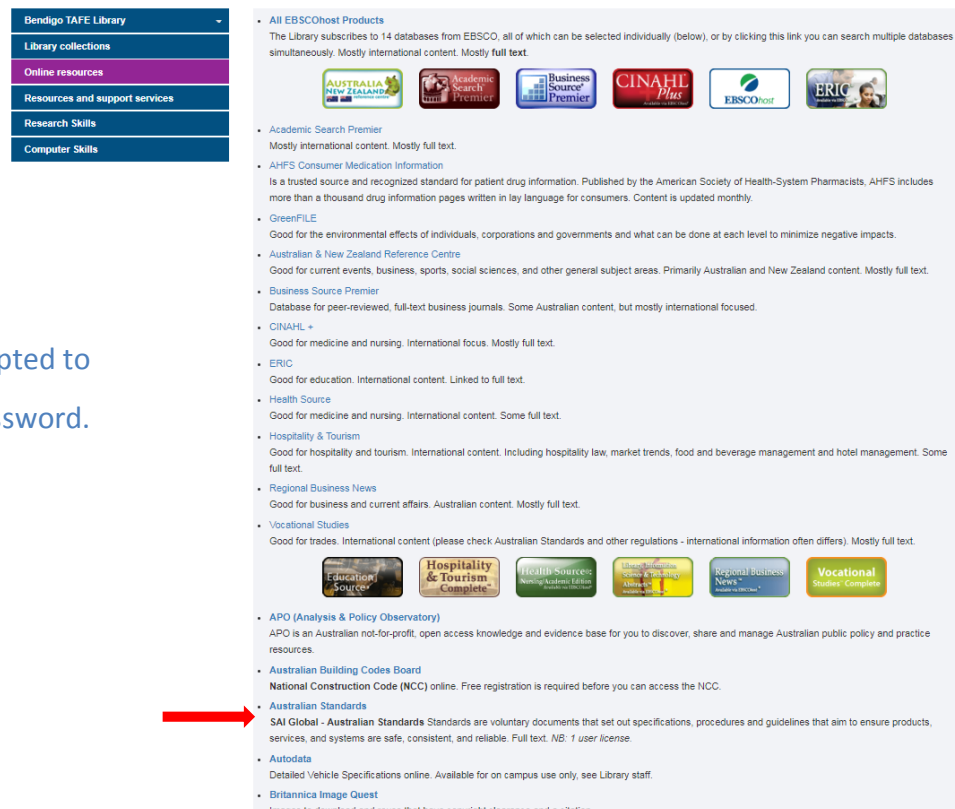
Standards on-line premium subscription provides access to the latest version of all Australian standards. The Library has a single user subscription, so you may need to try again later if you cannot connect immediately.

## 1. Access Australian Standards

- Go to <http://libguides.kangan.edu.au/bendigo>
- Select the **Online Resources** tab on the left side of the screen



- Select Australian Standards from the list of online resources. This list is alphabetical.

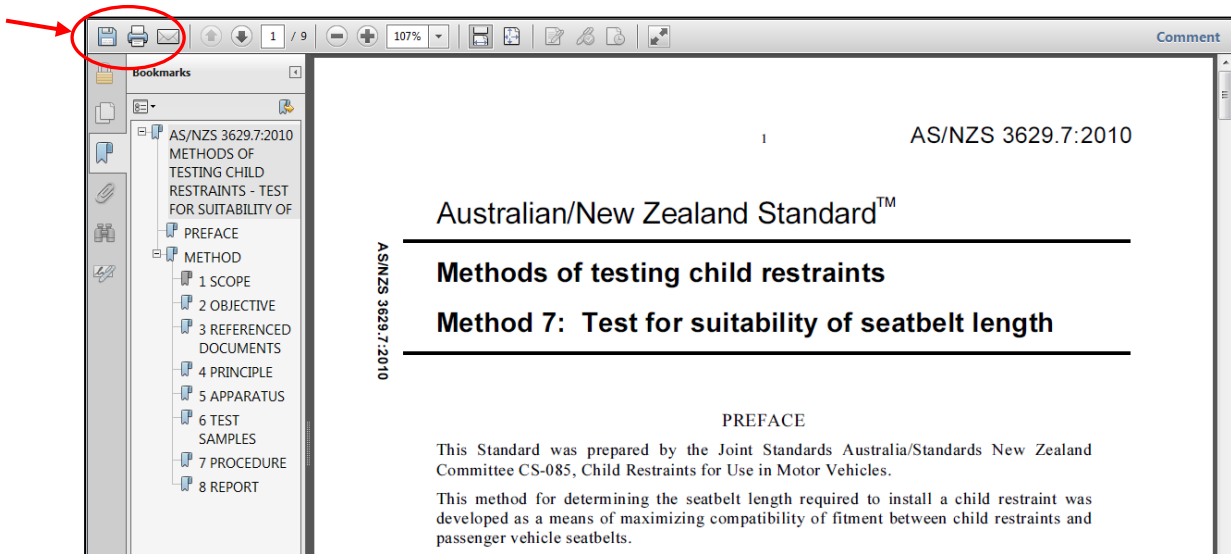

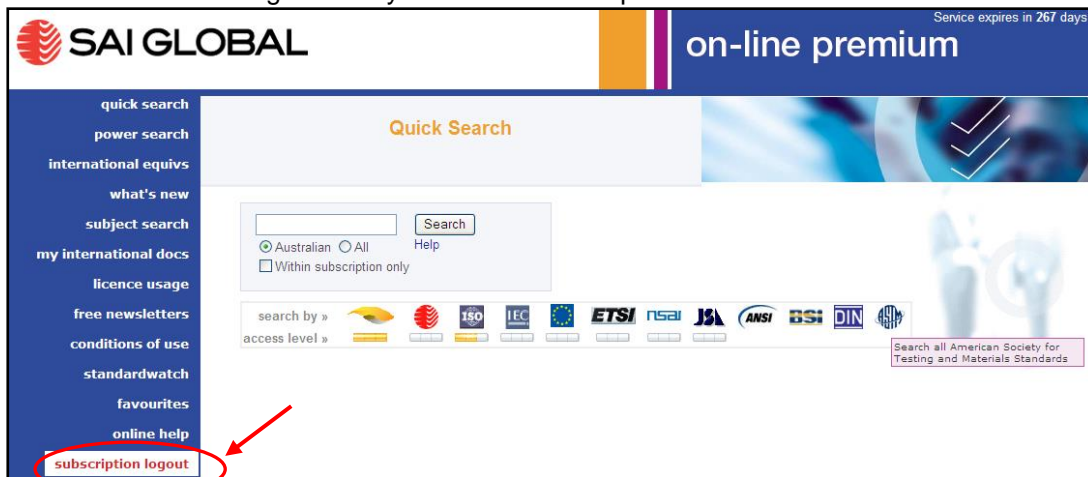
## Bendigo TAFE Library Downloading & Printing:
